JOB DESCRIPTION - TROPHY-AWARDS-MEDALS OFFICER

MAIN PURPOSE

To ensure medals and other awards are coordinated within SAMA and that all areas of the club have similar access to these rewards.

DUTIES

Liaise with the Run, Walk and Field Coordinators and the President in planning for the appropriate prize events and championships.

Maintain a record of who wins trophies each year and ensure that they are retrieved from members in time for their next presentation.

Where necessary, arrange for the purchase of trophies where a perpetual trophy is either not held by the recipient or it is tradition to award a personal trophy.

Arrange for medals to be prepared for the Club Track and Field Championships and the various winter run and walk championships. 1st, 2nd and 3rd are awarded in each 5 year age-group.

Summer Program.

January/Feb: Memorial Meeting:

J.Liascos Trophy (perpetual) for best Age Graded 100m. This trophy is presented and then returned. A separate trophy is awarded to be kept (supplied by David Janssen). Trophy for best Age Graded "other event" which includes runs, walks and field events. This winner is worked out at a later date and the presentation made at the summer awards night. Wording on the trophy could read: "*SAMA Memorial Meeting (date) -- Age Graded Winner*". (Frank Rogers currently works out the age grading.)

March/April: Club Championships:

Medals for all age group place getters, for financial members only. Medals are engraved by Ross Martin and he is to be supplied sufficient medals by the Trophy Steward. The list of award winners is supplied by the Program Co-ordinator after the results are processed.

Award Presentations:

After competition on the last competition night of the summer season.

Winter Programme.

Championship Events:

Walks: 10km, 15km, 20km.

Runs: 5 km Road, 10km Road, 8km Cross Country, Half Marathon.

Award Presentations:

Usually made at the last Saturday of the winter competition.

Trophy races: (Trophies presented at the end of competition)

Pat Peters Trophy – Walking Perpetual. 5Km. Yacht Handicap.

Jack Webber Trophy. –Walking Perpetual. 8Km. Yacht Handicap. Held at Sir Donald Bradman Drive course. Any time during Season. To be presented by Ruth if possible.

Royal Air forces Association – Walking Perpetual. 10Km. Yacht Handicap. To be competed for during 'Battle of Britain' week, second Saturday in September, if possible.
